- ii. Fulfilment of the minimum duration of study;
- Publication of TWO (2) Scopus/WOS-indexed articles OR ONE (1) Scopus/WOS-indexed article and TWO (2) articles from other indexed journals;
- iv. Submission of thesis between 80,000 100,000 words; AND
- v. Pass in viva voce.



Assessment Methods:

- i. Formative Assessment (Students are required to):
 - a. Attend and Pass Research Methodology course offered by the Graduate School and Law Research Methodology course offered by FUHA before Proposal Defence
 - b. Pass the research proposal presentation
 - c. Submit Progress Report (every semester)
 - d. Present progress of research at FUHA Postgraduate Colloquium
 - e. Pass the research findings presentation (before Notice of Submission)
 - f. Publications

ii. Summative Assessment:

- a. Examination of thesis by one internal examiner and two external examiners.
- b. Viva voce.
